What Victims' Counsel do for Sexual Assault and Domestic Violence victims?

- Provide confidential legal advice
- Protect your rights and privacy interests
- Advise you on the investigation and disposition process,
- Advocate for you in military investigative interviews, hearings, boards, and courts-martial.

Victims' Counsels are attorneys who form a protected attorney-client relationship with the victim.
